

*How Do I Prepare
Household Hazardous
Waste For Transport To
The Facility?*

- Check all containers and make sure the lids are on tight
- If the label is coming off, tape it back on
- If the container is leaking, put it in a larger container with an absorbent such as kitty litter
- Leave the product in the original container
- Use boxes lined with newspaper and/or trash bags
- Haul waste in the car trunk or truck bed only
- Do not mix products together



What Are Hazardous Materials, And Do I Have Any In My Home?

Look for these key words:

WARNING

CAUTION

DANGER

These products may have hazardous properties that are: **corrosive, reactive, toxic, flammable, or explosive.** Any product you no longer have a use for should be considered a waste and brought to the facility. Household Hazardous Waste is generally categorized into four main groups:

1. **Household Cleaners**
2. **Paints**
3. **Pest Control Products**
4. **Automotive Products**

If possible use the product according to label or recycle by giving it to someone else who can use the product!
