**SALES TAX:** Sales tax for the month of November, 2018 has been received in the amount of \$69,873.18.

**PAYDAY:** A detailed list of expenditures by fund was reviewed. Mileage logs and the cumulative comp time report were reviewed. The warrant register was approved and signed for a payday figure of \$1,176,004.99, including payroll at \$504,155.83. Checks #47226-47468; voided check #47261.
