7-101 Validity: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or provision of these regulations shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of these regulations as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

7-102 Accrued Rights and Liabilities Saved: The repeal of regulations provided in Section 7-105 herein, shall not affect any rights accrued, fines, penalties, forfeitures, or liabilities incurred thereunder, or actions involving any of the provisions of said regulations or parts thereof. Said regulations below repealed are hereby continued in force and effect, after the passage, approval and publication of these regulations, for the purpose of such rights, fines, penalties, forfeitures, liabilities and actions therefore.

7-103 Severability: Each article, section, and subdivision of a section of these regulations is hereby declared to be independent of every other article, section, or subdivision of a section, so far as inducement for the passage of these regulations is concerned.

7-104 Effective Date: These regulations, being designated as the "Subdivision Regulations of Marion County, Kansas", shall be in full force and effect within the unincorporated portion of Marion County, Kansas, from and after its passage and publication in accordance with K.S.A. 12-3301 through 12-3305.

7-105 Repealing Clause: These Regulations repeal all other rules, regulations, and/or resolutions of Marion County, Kansas, addressing matters contained within these Regulations in their entirety to the extent said rules, regulations, and/or resolutions conflict.
